



G Major Across the Whole Neck

- The guitar can be confusing, as there are so many ways to play the same notes.
- It helps to map out the notes in a one major key (with no open strings).
- The patterns you learn in one key apply to all major keys.
- This worksheet shows G major, the most natural major key on the guitar.
- These are the available notes within the key, not scales in the conventional sense.
- J This method give you the notes G major across all the strings within a limited number of frets.



- ✓ You can play all these patterns with a *maximum of one position change* (and one change back).










Starting in 7th position: Lowest note B
